General Instructions for authors

- Contributions may be written and presented in English.
- They must use non-sexist language.
- Contributions must be sent in full, in accordance with the “format and length of poster presentations”, on the established date.
- Each author may submit a maximum of two contributions to the Conference.
- There is no limit to the number of authors.
- All contributions will be evaluated anonymously by at least two members of the D-EMIND Consortium.
- It is compulsory to use the templates provided by the D-EMIND Conference for the writing of the contributions.

Format and Length of Poster Presentation

A poster is submitted and presented by, at least, **one author**.

The submission consists of a short abstract (600-800 words) with the following structure:

- **Research Posters: introduction, methods section, conclusions and references**
- **Innovation or Intervention Posters: introduction, innovation design, results, conclusions and references.**

Posters are graphical presentations printed in A1 size (594 x841 mm/ 23.3 x33.1 in) in portrait/upright format.

During the conference, posters are presented/displayed in in the General Poster Exhibition.

General Poster Exhibition

The Conference Poster Exhibition is open from Wednesday morning till Wednesday lunch. Presenters are asked to hang their poster in the Poster Exhibition Area by 10:00 Wednesday morning.

All poster authors presenting a poster must be at the Poster Exhibition Area to present their poster during the lunch break (12:00 – 13:00) on Wednesday. Poster authors should be prepared to explain their research or innovation and answer questions to the people who are attending the Poster Exhibition.
